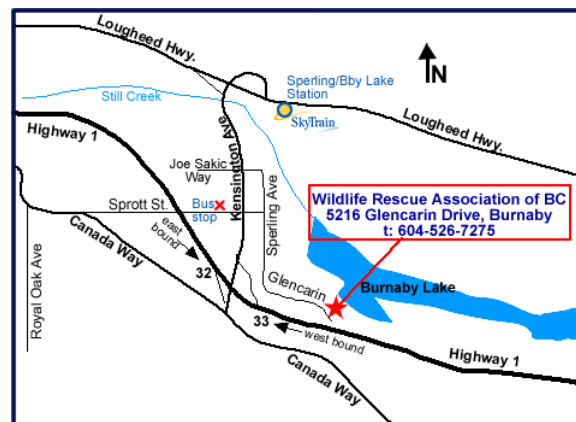
What's Happening In May:
